SURVEY AMBASSADORS

Area Ambassadors (4-6) are people situated around the different areas of the festival to ensure the smooth running of the areas and are a key part of the communications between the teams.

Times: From 10 am - 9 pm

*(*This important data helps us to apply for funding for future festivals)*



MAINTENANCE

FRIDAY 9pm-11pm

This involves a clean-up of the grounds following the Colour Blast Glow Edition so everything is organised for the main festival on the Saturday

SATURDAY

This role includes emptying bins, picking up rubbish, moving chairs and gazebos if required and generally helping on the day

Team/s required 2 noon - Close of Festival (approx 10pm)

Previously 3 people have done this job



SET UP & PACK UP

FRIDAY

Set up the Festival grounds for the Colour Blast Glow Edition

Saturday 12 noon - 10 pm

Set up Festival Grounds - This includes:

Putting out signage, lanterns, organising group stalls, beautification, bollards, bins, tables and chairs, etc

PACK-UP

The pack up of the grounds will this year be conducted on the Saturday night or Sunday morning depending on availability of volunteers

This is a large job and requires 12+ members to undertake this task



GATES

FRIDAY

We are looking for a group of 6 people to undertake the running of two gates.

The gates will run from **5:30 pm - 8:00 pm**

SATURDAY

We are looking for a group/s of 10 to 12 people to undertake the running of the 3 gates. 3 Different groups can apply!

There will be 3 Gates on Saturday & will run from **10:00 am - 8 pm**

GATE 1 - 3/4 PEOPLE | GATE 2 - 2 PEOPLE | GATE 3 - 2 PEOPLE
